Mercury gilt copper alloy with glass inlays
Nepalo-Chinese, Yuan, Imperial,
ca. last quarter of the 13th century,
Height: 22.4 cm (8.82 in.)



15. GUARDIAN

Copper alloy
Tibeto-Chinese
Early Ming, late 14th/early 15th century
Height: 34 cm (13.38 in.)



8. GREEN TARA

Mercury gilt copper alloy with glass inlays
Tibeto-Chinese
Yuan, 14th century
Height: 18.3 cm (7.2 in.)



20. SUTRA COVERS

Wood and red lacquer
Tibeto-Chinese
Ming, Yongle Period (ca. 1410 AD)
73 x 28.5 x 3.2 cm (28.74 x 11.22 x 1.26 in.) each



12. STUPA

Mercury gilt copper alloy
Tibeto-Chinese
Yuan, ca. mid-14th century
Height: 16.7 cm (8.57 in.)



28. LAMPAS CANOPY

Blue and gold-colored silk, Early Ming,
Imperial, third quarter of the 15th century,
Date supported by C14 analysis
89 x 87 cm (35 x 34.25 in.)
